

EQUIPMENT LIST

To take the MA Photography (international photojournalism, documentary and travel photography) you will need,

- A digital camera with interchangeable lenses (DSLR) – we recommend Nikon or Canon
- A lens range of 28mm to 200mm (35mm equivalent)
- A separate flash and a flash cable or remote that allows you to use the flash away from the camera
- A tripod
- A 250GB external hard drive to store your images from the year

If you don't live on or close to the campus you will also need,

- A computer capable of working with high resolution images and video
- A broadband internet connection
- A headset with microphone

Plus the following software,

- Microsoft Word and Powerpoint
- Adobe Photoshop (or equivalent)
- Adobe Bridge (this comes free with later versions of photoshop or equivalent)
- Adobe Premiere (or equivalent)
- Adobe Dreamweaver (or equivalent)

Please note all the above software packages are considerably cheaper if you buy the student versions please ask your tutor for details. All the Adobe packages also can be bought in one set. Instruction for the course will be done using the above software packages. If you choose to use an equivalent version you will be responsible for

If you plan to work on long-term projects away from the learning centres you will need,

- A laptop computer
